



(My favorite food/ drink is + N(s))

- **→** Talk about wants and needs
 - \Leftrightarrow S + like / likes + N(s). <u>Ex</u>: I like carrots.
- \Leftrightarrow S + don't / doesn't + like + N(s). I don't like cabbages.
- Do/Does + S + like + N(s)? Do you like tomatoes?


